

Chocolate Chip Cookie Ice Cream Sandwiches

1. Make the chocolate chip cookies of your choosing (Elizabeth likes the recipe on the back of the Nestle Tollhouse Chocolate Chips bag). Let cool.
2. Scoop a scoop of the ice cream of your choice on top of one chocolate chip cookie, and press another chocolate chip cookie down on top of it.
3. Wrap the sandwich in plastic wrap and put it in the freezer for at least 3 hours and up to 2 months. Yum!

You can use other types of cookies and ice cream flavors here, too! Whatever sounds good to you.
